"And though of course the music itself is special (my little sister Elspeth was cured of a terrible dropsy by having Brighter records played at her graveside), and as potent symbols of the socialist ideal go I can think of few better than SARAH (oh I know some think you're too extreme and find your high-principled dogma unpalatable - but I say think of a bottle of Quosh Grapefruit Drink; one mouthful taken neat leaves you retching, but dilute say 1 part Quosh to 5 parts water and you've got a cool refreshing drink, and SARAH's the same - a measure of concentrated Integrity in the thin watery fluids of pop), I think what I admire most is your attention to detail which is why, on purchasing my copy of "Popkiss", I was momentarily taken aback to find that the photo on the cheery insert DID NOT MATCH that on the record centre. Then I laughed: obviously that buffoon in Eastern Bloc had simply put the wrong one in. So I returned forthwith, and berated him soundly.
