Oh of course we all cried when the Field Mice split, and sure a little part of me died the day I heard that The Sea Urchins had gone a bit funny; and yes I took a bread-knead to my mother when she spilt Diet-Coke all over my autographed 14 Iced Bears poster and then laughed at me saying it wasn't even like it was one of them that did signed it anyway which just isn't true, it was the guy with the beard, the accordion-player - but I'm sure you'll forgive us our little emotional digressions!"

"And though of course the music itself is special (my little sister Elspeth was cured of a terrible droopy by having Brighter records played at her graveside), and as potent symbols of the socialist ideal go I can think of few better than SARAH (oh I know some think you're too extreme and find your high-principled dogma unpalatable - but I say think of a bottle of Quosh Grapefruit Drinks: one mouthful taken near leaves you reeling, but dilute say 1 part Quosh to 5 parts water and you've got a cool refreshing drink, and SARAH's the same - a measure of concentrated integrity in the thin watery fluids of pop), I think what I admire most is your attention to detail which is why, on purchasing my copy of "Popkiss", I was momentarily taken aback to find that the photo on the cheery insert DID NOT MATCH that on the record centre. Then I laughed; obviously that buffoon in Eastern Bloc had simply put the wrong one in. So I returned forthwith, and berated him soundly. "... and too much bloody dance music I suspect!" my little speech concluded, triumphantly.
