Yes, this is it!!! The new-look SARAH insert, slightly narrower but tons thicker - we like to use the word "chunky". Rather cramped and perhaps a bit harder to read, but somehow so much more independent - it will for instance stand up all by itself if you prop it against a wall and tell your friends not to blow on it. Also, should you be one of those people building a house from our inserts, you'll find these new ones a lot sturdier - and that means less sleepless nights worrying about the roof sagging, and less need for extensive external buttressing if you're an end-of-terrace.
