I don't know if you've noticed, but our 7" have started coming in plastic bags again, just like in the old days when everybody hated us. Why so, you ask, quite reasonably. Well - basically it's all to do with the recent runaway success of "Feral Pop Frenzy". And, more particularly, an NME review which promised that "these madcap Australians" were "destined to break the Sarah mould". You see - having long-despaired of EVER breaking that mould, we suddenly sensed here a golden opportunity; but it needed more than one band, it needed A MOVEMENT...

And our bands haven't let us down. Why, only last week I witnessed the first crate-load of inflatable wombats being delivered to Blueboy HQ. And, whenever I think back to that cold February morning on the banks of The Aire, and Gentle Despite surfing down through Leeds with their didgeridoos flapping in the breeze, I fill with unspeakable pride.
