But of course it's juvenile crime that proves most emotive - kids supposedly growing up with no concept of good or evil, of right and wrong - and people get on their hobby-horses and blame the parents, the schools, or television's cartoon violence - and many, of course, bring a possible of the parents of up RELIGION, claiming a few minutes each day devoted to instilling good Christian values would solve it all.

But here at SARAH, where obviously we're slightly more in touch with young people than, say, Simon Mayo, I'm not so sure; I find it hard to be so bleak. Perhaps it's because I'm a scientist by training, and thus not much given to vague metaphysical rumblings about the state of the human soul - if I see a mixed-infant trying to set light to a poodle then I put it down not to lack of prayers in assembly but to natural curiosity, a project perhaps on the comparative flammabilities of different breeds. Or perhaps - deep breath - it's just because the folk who buy our records always seem somehow intrinsically much NICER - not at all the sort you'd expect to find dismantling a shop-front or dismembering an aged relative; and then I start to wonder: were they like this before they found SARAH, or is it something we've instilled in them over 5½ years of Brighter, Heavenly and Secret Shine?

Er - I don't know if any of you have ever noticed how, compared to other label's records, ours tend to - how can I put this - "glow"? Makes you think, doesn't it...
