I won't pretend to understand how it all works lasers and things, digital bits - we might well be thrusting away at the cutting edge of popular music, but l'm afraid I've not really kept up with all the parallel technological advances - it's hard enough to credit that 5½ years ago, when SARAH began, everything was recorded onto nice chunky ½" reel-to-reel analogue tape and "master-tape" meant MASTER-tape - it was the only one anywhere and was as unique as you or me, especially me, and everything else was a second or third or fourth generation copy and each successive copy was inferior to the last. And if you lost the master, that was that; ever wondered why The Autumn Store Part 1 only had 2 songs on and thus didn't balance the 3 song Part 2? Ask the sorting-office in Portsmouth. Ever wondered why a parcel posted in Croydon and destined for Bristol should go via Portsmouth? We used to... Portsmouth? We used to...

But now of course everything's digitalised and the hundredth copy's as good as the original, and anyone who wants to press up bootleg copies of "Pristine Christine" using the CD version of "Stardust" as a master would find it easy as pie. They'd get their legs broken, of course, but that's just our way.

Anyway, to come to a point, the <u>most</u> exciting thing about this CD-player is that we can <u>now</u> hear what all these things we've been releasing actually sound like and, frankly, it's bloody good stuff. And we recommend you buy it all. Now. Go on. (Prices opposite.)
