Now - I don't know if you can see, but just behind the gateway in the foreground, to the right of the explanatory notice-board, there are some stone steps disappearing down into the darkness, and this is the "sally port", entrance to a secret underground passageway which would've been used for discreetly abandoning the castle in times of trouble (e.g. dragons - see later) or perhaps for mounting surprise counter-attacks on besieging troops - obviously the notice-board wouldn't have been there in medieval times to give the game away. I'm not sure who the people walking up the path above the gateway are, I think they probably just popped out for a spot of lunch as there's a couple of DK-ish sandwich places over by Bristol Bridge, but if you can maybe imagine them done-up in chain-mail, visors and those things they used to have to stop their thighs chafing, you'll have some inkling of how it used to be. Dragons, they used to have dragons too, so maybe imagine one of those looming above, all shiny green scales and talons and smoking nostrils. Times were tough. Actually dragons were more Dark Ages than medieval, so it'd be wooden palisades not stone ramparts, hum - the years all blur together after a while. But then I reckon in centuries to come people will look back on our remains and get muddled between one century and the next, or one decade - that was always The Sea Urchins' problem, in a way, so I guess it's already begun.
